Format:

- An approved QBA GOLD point congress played under QBA Regulations.
- Contestants entering the event are deemed to have agreed to abide by the QBA Regulations and any supplementary regulations made by the tournament organiser's as;
 - either posted on the QBA website prior to the start of the event; or
 - by appearing on the entry form; or
 - by announcement before the start of the event.
- ▲ Each player must have a currently approved ABF system card and is responsible for ensuring the correctness of their classification. Green, Blue and Red Systems and Brown Sticker Conventions and Treatments are permitted.
- Masterpoints are not guaranteed unless correct ABF numbers are provided.

Other:

- **★** Teams must nominate either as a <u>contending</u> or <u>non-contending</u> team by the commencement of play.
- ★ Teams are allowed only one (1) non-Member player.

GNOT Qualifying Conditions

- 1. Two sessions will be held, one session on **Monday 8**th **July** at 7.15pm and the second session on **Monday 15**th **July** at 7.15pm.
- Teams are allowed only one (1) non-Member player.
 Each player must be a financial member of a Brisbane Zone ("BZ") club.
 A team may comprise 4 to 6 players.
- 3. A player may play in more than one zone and/or in more than one team within a zone so long as they are not playing in overlapping events in two teams that are both contending for a place in the zone finals or have already qualified in a team.
- 4. Teams must nominate either as a <u>contending</u> or <u>non-contending</u> team by the commencement of the club qualifying event.
- 5. Continuation from the club elimination round to area finals is not compulsory.
- 6. QBA regulations apply for this event. Refer to the tournament regulations on the QBA website regarding substitutions.
- 7. The Brisbane Zone finals will be held at Queensland Contract Bridge Club (QCBC) on Saturday 24 and Sunday 25 August 2024 starting at 9:30 am each day.
