## NSBC COVID-SAFE PLAN – JULY 2022

### Individual Responsibility

*The most important thing an individual must do is stay home if they are unwell.*

#### **If a Member Receives a Positive Diagnosis**

If a member tests positive, they are to follow all the recommended guidelines as regulated by the Queensland Department of Health.

#### **Notification Requirements if a Member Receives a Positive Diagnosis**

Members are not required to notify the club.

However, it is expected members will follow all necessary protocols regarding the safety and spread to other persons.

### Revised NSBC Covid-19 Safe Plan

In line with community expectations and decreasing public concern regarding the perceived likelihood of catching Covid-19, the NSBC Covid-19 Safe Plan has been revised.

#### **Upon entry to NSBC:**

There is no longer the requirement for:

- Proof of Vaccination to be sighted.
- Vaccination against COVID i.e. unvaccinated persons may enter the premises.
- The use of the QLD Health (“QH”) Check In App / QR Code.
- Capacity limits with the Club able to provide sessions for up to 36 tables.

#### **Players will comply as follows:**

- North is the only person to touch the bridgemate during play.
- Players to use the pen they started with for the entire session. East-West take their pens with them.
- Hand sanitise before and after lunch breaks.
- Sanitise pens, bridgemates, tables, chairs, side tables at the conclusion of play.
- Call the Director if a player is unwell.

#### **Players should:**

- Hand sanitise before or after each round.
- Maintain the regulated 1.5m distance when lining up for refreshments at tea break.
- Exit the clubrooms trying to maintain the 1.5m distance.

By your attendance at a session, you are agreeing to follow the above Revised Plan.

Notwithstanding these Covid requirements, members will at all times be responsible for their personal safety. NSBC does not assume responsibility for member’s or any individual’s personal safety and in addition does not assume responsibility for member’s or any individual’s compliance with the above mentioned Covid requirements or the law.
