Format:

- ♠ QBA approved Red Masterpoint congress. QBA Regulations apply.
- ♠ Contestants entering the event are deemed to have agreed to abide by the QBA Regulations and any supplementary regulations made by the tournament organiser's as;
 - either posted on the QBA website prior to the start of the event; or
 - by appearing on the entry form; or
 - by announcement before the start of the event.
- ▲ Each player must have a currently approved ABF system card and is responsible for ensuring the correctness of their classification. Green, Blue and Red Systems and Brown Sticker Conventions and Treatments are permitted.
- ▲ Masterpoints are not guaranteed unless correct ABF numbers are provided.
