From the 1st February, Home members pay \$57.80 and Away members \$25.

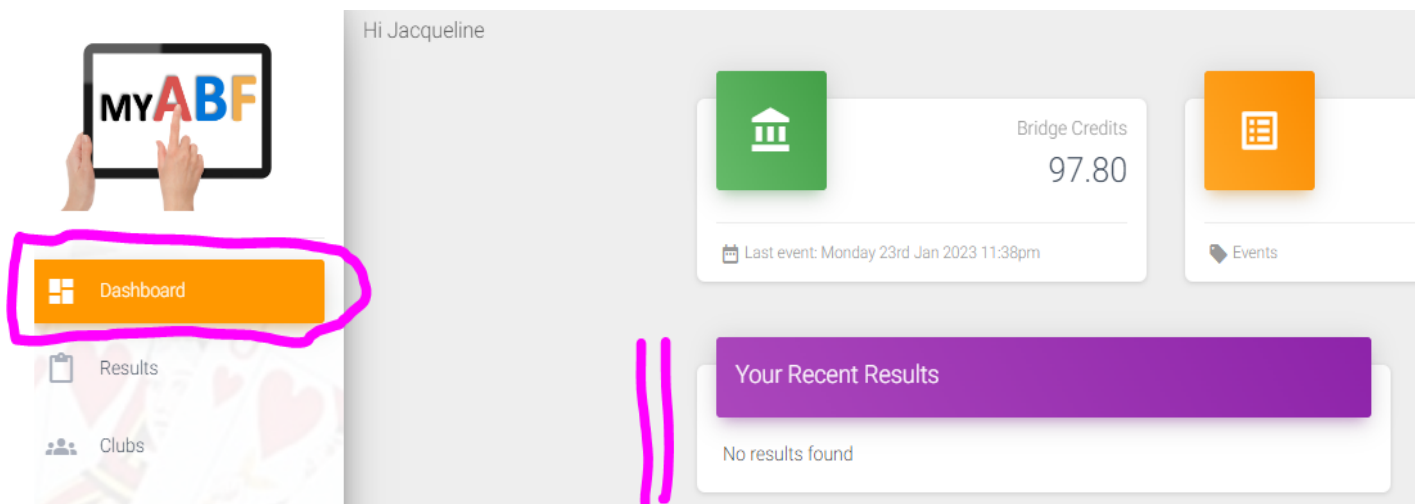
It would be much appreciated if members could pay their subscriptions by the due date to save the substantial amount of time spent in the past following up on renewals.

One of the new services offered in the current Payment for Sessions ("P4S") rollout is the ability to email players their session results. You will be able to see all the features available on the web site.
