

# About ... Jill Wilson

Jill Wilson was NSBC President from 1990-1997. In 1984, she formed a building Committee and was part of a successful application to lease unoccupied land on the current site of our Clubhouse. The bank required a sizeable deposit for construction of the Clubhouse. So strong was Jill's belief in the club, its members and its future, Jill generously offered her own house as collateral for a bank loan. The four member Building Committee, including Jill, were all women. The clubhouse took 4 months to build, completion & first play was in December 1991. Officially opened January 1992. Jill passed away 9 March 2019. At the April 2019 AGM, it was unanimously agreed to name the Clubhouse the "Jill Wilson Building" and she is also remembered during the annual Jill Wilson Championship Pairs.

#### **SOLUTION TO BRAIN REASER #5**

#### North

Spades -

Hearts A K Q J 7 2 Diamonds A 9 3 Clubs 10 8 6 5

South is in 6 Hearts after West leads the 7 Clubs.

This hand is a classic example of why you should always take time to think at trick one because careful examination will show you that the Clubs are blocked by the South hand. If you blithely draw trumps and then play the three top Clubs, you will find to your horror that you cannot avoid two Diamond losers.

After winning the opening lead with the Ace of Clubs, South should draw trumps in three rounds, then play a club to the King and exit with a Spade, discarding a Club from hand. Now that the clubs are unblocked, South will win any return and play his last Club to the Queen, discarding the two losing Diamonds on the remaining two Clubs.


